






LEVEL GROUPS (ELP)




MODULAR SYSTEM

 Common European Framework of Reference for Languages




PREPARATORY CLASS PASSING GRADE



MODULE AVERAGE CALCULATION

■The passing grade for each module is 60; unsuccessful students repeat the same module.



ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION

- ■The in-semester score is the average of the four modules the student has studied during the academic year.
- ■At the end of the year, the student who completes the B1 module can take the final exam.
- ■When calculating the student's Preparatory Class Passing Grade, 50% of the insemester grade and 50% of the Final/Make-Up Exam are taken.

FINAL/MAKE-UP EXAM & SUMMER SCHOOL

- Students who fail due to absenteeism cannot attend the final exam, make-up exam, and summer school.
- Those who attend the classes and have a grade of at least 50 average during the academic year can take the final/make-up exams.
- Students with an in-semester grade at least 45 average can enroll in summer school.

SECOND YEAR IN PREP SCHOOL

- Students who fail at the end of the first year of preparatory class education can take the September
 English Proficiency Exam/Student Placement Exam.
- Students who fail this exam can take one more year of English preparatory education.

However, students who want to take only English Proficiency Exam and final/make-up exams without attending the preparatory classes for another year should apply to our Student Affair Secretary with a petition within the add-drop dates at GİBTÜ academic calendar; these students cannot attend the following summer school.

DISMISSAL FROM PREP SCHOOL

Students who fail at the end of the maximum preparatory education period (2 years)

are dismissed from the program in which they are accepted. For students who have

been dismissed, the provisions of the relevant legislation are applied.

QUIZZES

☐ In each module, 3-4 quizzes assessing listening, grammar, vocabulary, and reading skills, 1 of 3-4 quizzes assess writing or speaking skills.

☐ They contribute to the module average 20%.


MODULE EXIT EXAMS

☐ These are comprehensive exams that are administered 4 times a year (at the end of each module) in total and assess listening, grammar, vocabulary, and reading skills.

☐ They contribute to the module average 65%.

FINAL/MAKE-UP EXAM

The final/make-up exam is conducted at the end of the academic year. These exams are made of three stages:



- •Your average grade point must be at least 50,
- •You must not fail due to absenteeism.


EXEMPTION FROM THE FINAL EXAM

- 1. General absenteeism not exceeding 10%
- 2. Successfully passed each module
- 3. GPA 80 or higher
- 4. Students who meet these conditions are exempted from the final exam and can continue their education in their departments when they complete the preparation class education.

SUMMER SCHOOL

- Students with a grade of 45 average or higher during the year can attend summer school.
- The summer school is optional.
- You have to attend summer school courses.
- Students who cannot meet the attendance requirement cannot take any exam, including the final exam to be taken at the end of summer school.
- Students who achieve a score of 70 average and above after the assessment criteria (Quiz 20% + Final Exam 75% + Teacher Evaluation 5%) are considered successful in the summer school.

SUMMER SCHOOL GRADE CALCULATION




PROFICIENCY EXAMS

- ■A total of 2 proficiency exams are administered in one academic year.
- It is held at the beginning of the 1st and 2nd semesters.
- Successful students can register for their courses in their departments.
- •Students who complete the B1 level with an average of at least 85 and those who successfully complete the B2 level are entitled to take the mid-term proficiency exam.

PROFICIENCY EXAMS

Proficiency exams consist of three stages:



■In order to enter the second and third stages of the exam, it is necessary to get at least 35 from the first stage.

MATTERS REQUIRING YOUR ATTENTION

- Make sure you have your student ID and dormitory cards during the exams.
- Be ready to show your student ID when requested by the academic staff in charge.
- Do not leave your bags, wallets, books, mobile phones, and any belongings in the classrooms in case they are lost or stolen.
- GİBTÜ and the School of Foreign Languages are not responsible for lost and stolen items.

MATTERS REQUIRING YOUR ATTENTION

- Posters and announcements can only be posted on the bulletin board after obtaining permissions of the Rectorate and informing the management.
- Buildings and the environment should be kept clean and the inventory stock belonging to our university should be used carefully.
- Deliberate or inadvertent damages are recorded and the resulting damage is compensated by the person.
